

The Second Annual Flapjack Flats 20k TT

in Florence, AZ
Saturday February 7, 2009

Promoted by Summit Velo Tucson and held under USA Cycling Permit (Pending)

This pancake-flat, out and back time trial will be held on the Arizona Farms Rd between AZ-79 and Hunt Hwy. The start/finish will be approx one mile west of AZ-79. EMT and porta-johns will be onsite there as well. BEST of all, there will be FREE flapjacks there after the race.

Day-of-Registration will be held on site from 7 to 7:45am, first rider off at 8am. Preregistration will be held on February 6 at Fairwheel Bikes in Tucson from 4 to 6pm. One-day and Annual USCF licenses will be available at both times, for \$10 and \$60 respectively. Registration will be \$20 per rider and \$5 per junior rider. The fastest rider in each category containing FIVE OR MORE riders will receive \$20 cash.

Total distance for the course will be 20k or 12.4 miles for all categories. There will be race volunteers directing traffic at the start/finish and turnaround, but keep in mind that the course IS OPEN to traffic so be aware, and stay as far to the right as is safe and reasonable at all times.

Don't have all that fancy aero gear, or want to time trial in the old style?? Flapjack Flats also features a "Merckx" Open category for Men and Women willing to ride like the Cannibal--no funny helmets, skinsuits, aero bars or disc wheels allowed here!

Directions to Arizona Farms Rd: From the East Valley, take US-60 to Florence Junction and go south on AZ-79. From Tucson, take Oracle Rd north to Oracle Junction and bear left onto AZ-79 north. From anywhere else, take I-10 to either AZ-287 or 387 and follow signs to Florence, then go north on AZ-79. Signs will be posted at the intersection of Arizona Farms and AZ-79.
